problem	possible solution
Bad language, inappropriate content	You could select several video that are appropriate for your students and ask them to watch and use these
Unfriendly comments	Videos you upload should not be viewable for everyone, you should lock them
dubious website (content, author, data protection, advertisement...): as all US-based social media platform YouTube uses data for commercial purposes	consent of the parents and the learner is needed you could use a class-account to upload videos
Students cannot use popular music to illustrate their videos	YouTube provides free music
